General Business

Discussion Summary		
Year of 2020		
Brynn provided a summary of his Chair's report to the meeting.		
CNZ Schools managed to deliver two events last year and are back to full delivery this year. Two new events have been added to the Schools calendar - two Island Cyclo X events will be held this year mid year.		
Initiatives undertaken during the year included:		
<ul style="list-style-type: none">- establishing a new focus group of students (who had their first meeting in March) to be a voice for the riders.- confirming Skoda as our naming sponsor for all events for the next two years.- Updating our school rules to align with Bike Road and Track (including allowing Carbon wheels).		
Over the weekend, the Exec has been looking at the events calendar and there is work being undertaken by CNZ to co-ordinate events of the four member organisations.		
Also we are proposing a change to the way we deal with over-subscribed events. Rather than limiting initial entry numbers, it is proposed that (i) entry dates would be brought forward, (ii) all schools would be entitled to enter all their riders (with proviso that Schools may need to reduce their numbers if entry numbers exceeded places available), (iii) once entry closing dates have passed, CNZS/event managers would determine whether event numbers would need to be limited and , if they were, CNZS would identify (and advise) schools where entries needed to be reduced – based on the factors currently identified in the Schools Rules.		
Last night CNZ held an awards ceremony and we had the opportunity to congratulate our award winners - Tessa Jenkins from Auckland in developing cycling at St Kentigern College (Road, track and MTB), Jon Hasler for Auckland Mountain bike series and Marie Laycock for her very long service as Secretary/Treasurer of Cycling New Zealand Schools.		
Brynn noted that Meshy will be stepping down as Waikato rep and thanked her for her contribution. He also noted a member of the Student focus group (Devon Briggs) was recognised as para cyclist for the year.
