



## 2024 Schools Cycling Passion Awards

- Overview** CNZ Schools want to celebrate and recognise those riders off the podium that turn up and try their best and have a good attitude. We want to create an award that the riders can strive to win by displaying good sportsmanship in our Schools Cycling events. We hope this will encourage good behaviour and participation and become a goal for any rider who takes part.
- How it works** CNZ Schools will have sponsored items to give to each event organiser to award to the deserving winners. The organisers can also provide items to be awarded from their own event sponsors. CNZ Schools will work with organisers to avoid any sponsor clashes of same industry items.
- Awards** The goal will be to have 2-4 awards at each event to be presented at the end of the event at the final prizegiving. If the event has multiple days and presentations the awards should be split across each day and 1 can be awarded at each prize giving for example.
- Criteria** The criteria for selection should include the following if possible:
- Even gender balance
  - Even range of grades
  - Even range of disciplines (ie 1 XCO rider, 1 DH rider)
  - Diverse selection of schools if possible
- Reasoning** The reason for selecting the winner could include:
- Good attitude
  - Trying their best
  - Trying something new
  - Helping a fellow rider in the race
  - Showing respect towards fellow riders and commissaires
  - Learning
- Selection** The selection panel should include:
- The event organisers
  - CNZ Rep
  - CNZS Executive Rep
  - Commissaires
